

## Information on arrival and material list

## Bring along:

- Slippers Slippers are obligatory in our hut.
- Ear plugs the hut is very noisy.
- A good book for downdays.
- Flip Flops for the shower.
- A thermos if needed.

## We have on site:

- Beds including duvets, pillows and blankets
- towels, bathrobes
- Limited internet (4G), electricity and mobile phone reception (European standard sockets)
- Local SIM cards can be borrowed from us (€10 per week +50,-€ deposit)
- We have wine and beer at the hut. Please don't bring it!



#### Ski & safety equipment:

- Freeride skis with touring bindings and skins or splitboard with skins. Crampons are not required. We are out in the open ski area there are also rocks and stones, maybe don't bring your newest equipment.
- LVS, probe, shovel mandatory.
- We strongly recommend an airbag (possible to rent by prior arrangement) and a helmet.
- In addition, a bivvy sack, rescue blanket and a first aid kit are advisable.

# About the luggage:

- The luggage transport to the hut is complex please limit yourself to the essentials!
- WizzAir now officially takes cartridges with it. If in doubt, leave the cartridge behind and borrow it from us (€20 per week Mammut, ABS, Ortovox).
- The **sports luggage** is cheap. Wizzair officially allows a separate bag for ski boots, but this is not always accepted on site.
- Definitely check-in at Wizzair via the Internet. It costs significantly more at the airport.

## For arrival:

- We pick you up at the airport. Please provide us with a mobile phone number prior to departure so that we can contact you in the event of a flight delay or rerouting.
- Please have warm clothing and snowproof shoes ready to hand, as we will transfer to the Snowcat during the journey. We may also go skiing on the day of arrival!

## Theme money:

Drinks or any rental equipment (with advance notice) in our hut can be paid in lari, euros, Swiss francs or USD. Payment with credit cards is not possible at the hut!
